

GUIDELINES FOR COMMUNITY OUTREACH GRANT

The grant is created to recognize the uniqueness of dance to help people of all ages and all walks of life achieve mental and physical development. It is designed to help start programs or fund special projects within established programs.

Programs that will be considered should use dance within a non-dance community with the goal of encouraging any of the following: innovation, creativity, collaboration, inclusiveness, enjoyment, mutual respect and artistic exploration. Grant money must be used between February 1 and December 31 of the award year.
