

NYC Dance Deconstructed Residency/Gibney Dance - \$500 Grant

NYC Dance Deconstructed is designed to guide dancers to explore the myriad opportunities that exist to have a meaningful and creative career in dance. Residencies may include: Master Classes, Collaboration and Creative Process Workshops, Panel Discussions, Social Action Workshops, Digital Technology Training, Career Planning, Entrepreneurship and Economic Empowerment, Performance Opportunities, Curated NYC performance and tour packages, and Alumni Gatherings. Grant Guidelines:

The Dance Pathways grant is created to assist in the funding of a group program at Gibney Dance in NYC. School faculty members work with Gibney Dance Staff to create a series of classes tailor made to fit the needs and aspirations of their dancers. Residencies can be any length from 1 day, 3 days, and 5 days or beyond. Options range from technique classes to panel discussions with working professionals, and from community involvement to the creative process.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Applicant must be a decision maker and have fiscal responsibility for the college, studio, or high school program
- All NYC Dance Deconstructed programs are held at Gibney Dance in NYC and are 100% customizable. Programs, classes, and event dates are subject to availability.
- Award of a grant does not guarantee specific dates will be available
- Grant money will be subtracted from the total amount due once residency is confirmed and invoiced
